Course Introduction & Aims:

Dreamweaver is the premiere web design package used by around 70% of the world's web design firms. It allows for the quick and efficient building of complex websites without overwhelming the new user with more information than is required.

This course will introduce many of Dreamweaver's construction and management tools. During the course you will look at creating linked HTML pages, which will include text, images, tables, forms, framesets and cascading style sheets. To enhance this knowledge methods of automating and managing the content will also be explored through the use of templates, libraries and Dreamweaver's site menu.

The course is split into four logical elements, which will give you a solid grounding in the key areas of site design, construction and management.
